**AUDIENCE COMMENTS**: Sheriff Dan Bean reported Stats for the month of December compared to a year ago December up slightly on total calls to service, Sheriff Bean also compared full year comparing 2016 to 2015. Total calls to service decreased by approximately 12% in 2016. Sheriff Bean expressed concerns about Medical Marijuana Facilities and informed us of a
