

Minutes of July 16, 2007

Regular Board Meeting

Gerald Patrick called the regular meeting of the Mancelona Township Board to order on July 16, 2007 at 7:00 p.m. in the Mancelona Township Offices. Roll Call was taken. Present: Margaret Chapman, Dan Bean, Maurice McGleish, Gerald Patrick, and Cathy Sue Robinson.

Absent: None.

Also present: Barry Cole, legal counsel.

Motion by Sue Robinson, supported by Dan Beanto accept the minutes of the June 18, 2007 regular meeting. Motion carried.

The current bills were presented to the Board. Motion by Margaret Chapman, supported by Maurice McGleish to approve the current expenditures as follows:

Karla Stephens addressed the Board with comments regarding the library and results of surveys completed by people. There was also

some comments by the librarian in this regard. Supervisor Patrick appointed a committee who will review the library program and report to the Board once they have completed their review.

Late comments were made by Ms Roose regarding payment of taxes on the building by the township.

OLD BUSINESS:

Counsel Barry Cole presented the Board with a modified Resolution 07-06, Fire Cadet-Explorer Program. Thereafter a motion was presented by Maurice McGleish, supported by Dan Bean. Roll call vote was taken. Ayes: Dan Bean, Margaret Chapman, Gerald Patrick, Sue Robinson, Maurice McGleish. Nays: None. The resolution was declared adopted.

A motion was presented by Maurice McGleish, supported by Margaret Chapman to approve a junkyard permit for Gabby's Recycling. Motion carried. Thereafter, a motion was presented by Maurice McGleish, supported by Sue Robinson to approve the application for Class C License for Gabby's Recycling. Motion carried.

Fred Buhland addressed the issue of the proposed walking path. The matter of an agreement with Wade Trim for the study of the walking path was discussed and Barry Cole agreed to make appropriate changes to the agreement stating the township's total liability being \$2200.00. Thereafter, the Board agreed to continue with the study.

NEW BUSINESS:

- a. Approval of the junkyard permit application for Gabby's Recycling. This matter was addressed under old business above.
