**FIRE DEPARTMENT:** Fire Chief, Chris Orman, submitted a written and report for fire activities for April 2026, 54 total calls 28 Rescue and Emergency, this includes the Village and Custer. Added 5 to roster waiting on 4 physicals. Total calls from January 1<sup>s</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup> 231.

**LIBRARY:** Sarah Apps and Paula Dixon submitted a written report for April 2026, things are going well. The Children's program, especially with story time, 84 Children, 25 Adults, overall numbers up considerably from a year ago. Working on book sale Memorial weekend.

**CONSTABLE:** Constable Denny Corrado presented a written and verbal report. 25 open cases 3 closed through compliance, very busy checking out complaints and dealing with them. Completed background checks for fire Department with no issues.
